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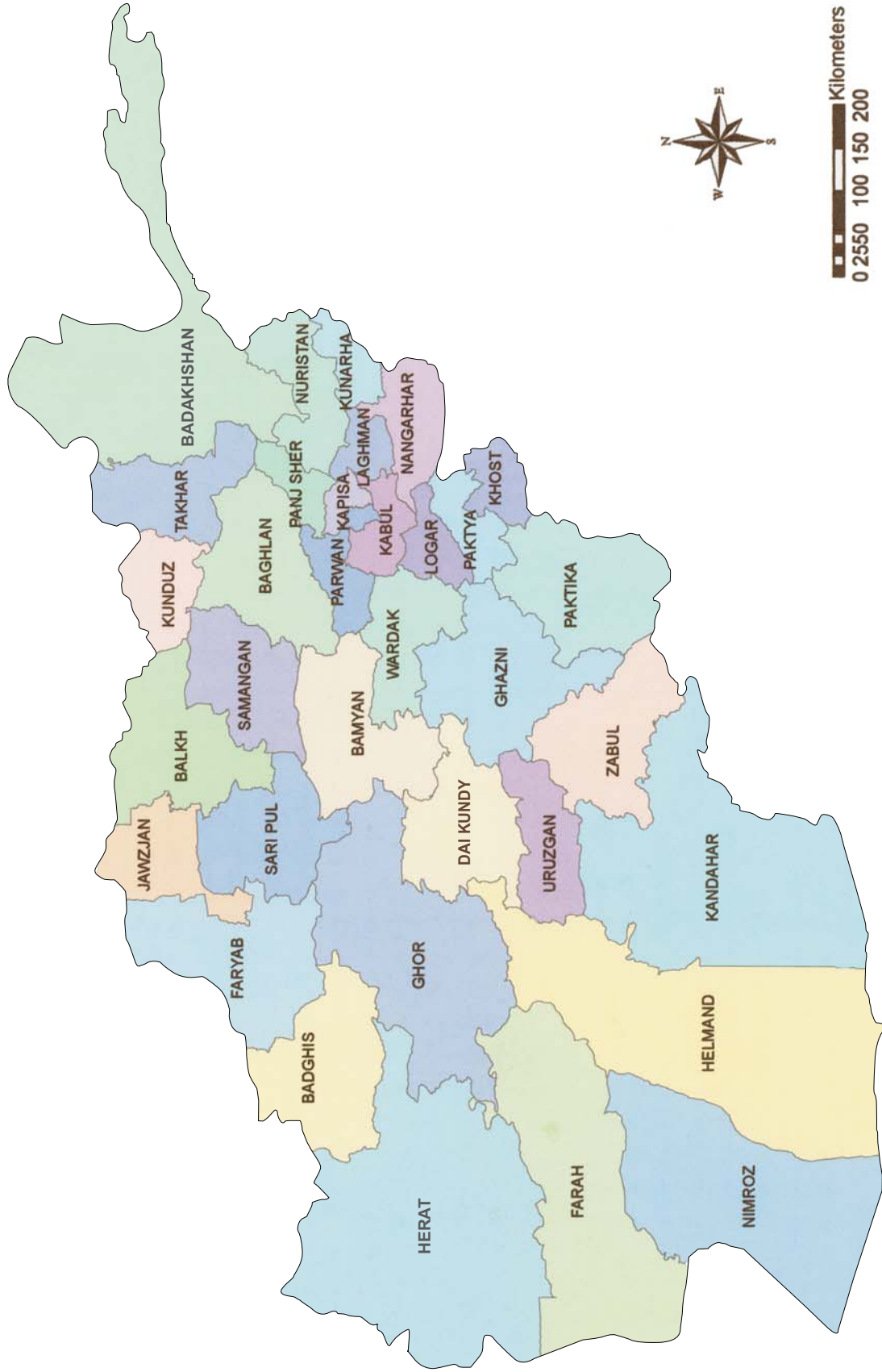


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MAP OF AFGHANISTAN

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1. Consumer Price Index (CPI)

National Consumer Price Index (CPI) in October 2008¹ was higher by 50.6 percent points than in the same month last year. The annual increase in the national food index was 73.3 percent points. Among food items, annual rise is highest (up 138.0 percent points) for “bread and cereals”. The non-food index showed a reasonable annual increase of 14.6 percent points. There was an increase of 3.1 percent points in the exchange-rate index in the said period. (Table 1/Annex I&II)

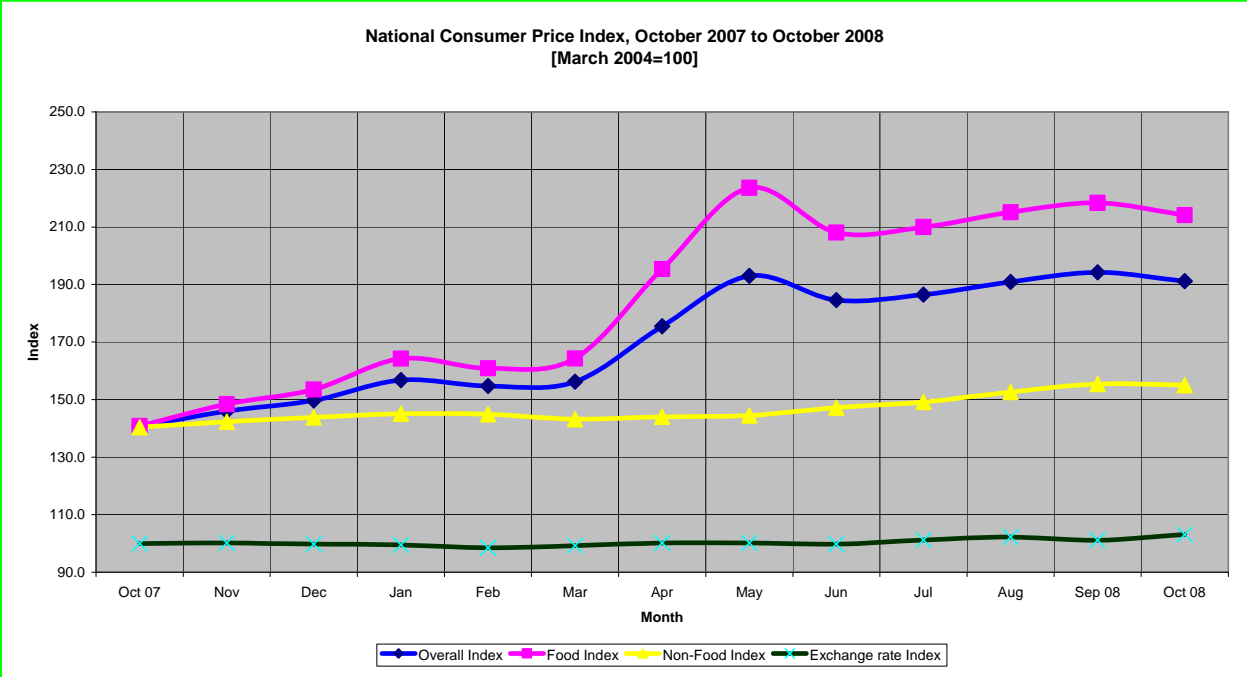

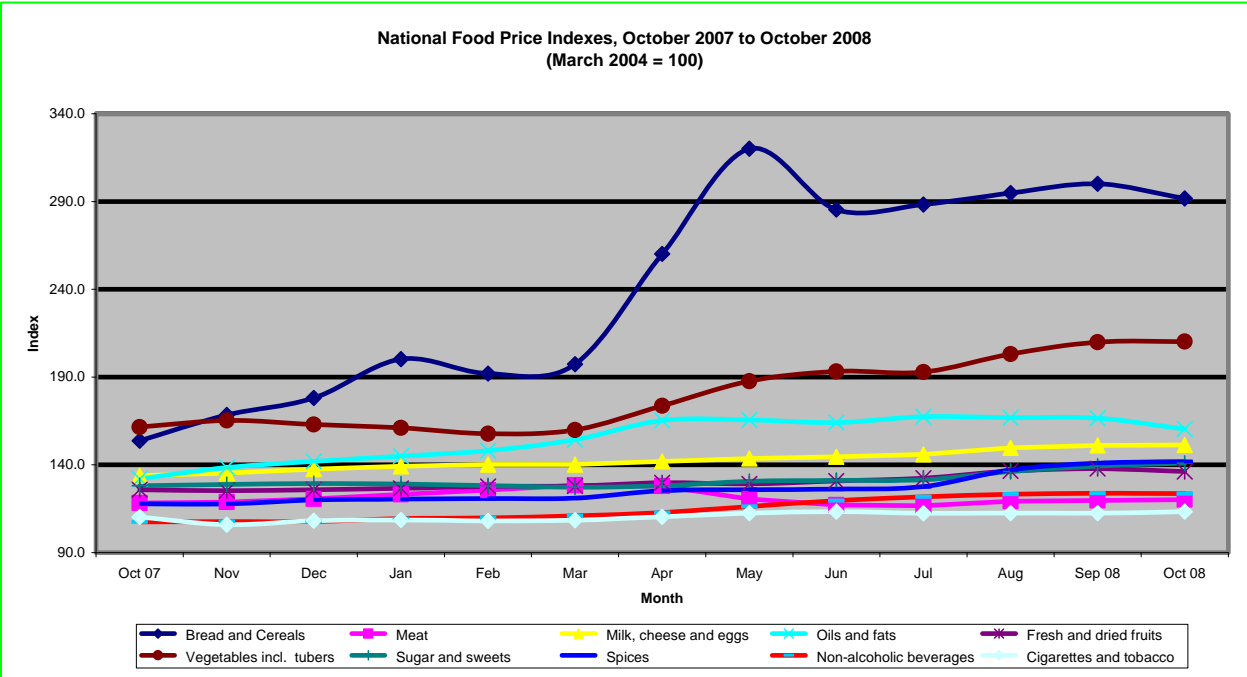
CPIs for food items indicate that there is a very sharp rise in the prices of food items. Annual increases in the food indexes were as follows: Bread and cereals (+138.0 percent points); Vegetables including tubers (+48.7); Oil and fats (+28.4 percent points); Spices (+24.0); Milk cheese and egg (+17.5); Non-alcoholic beverages (+16.1); Sugar and sweets (12.9); Fresh and dry fruits (+10.3); Cigarettes and tobacco (3.1) and Meat (+1.8). (Table 1)

From September to October 2008, overall CPI decreased by 2.8 percent points, with a decrease in food index by 4.2 and of non-food index by 0.4 percent point. The exchange-rate increased by 2.0 percent points in the said period. (Table 1/Annex II)

¹ Consumer Price Index (CPI) is an index of the price of consumer goods and services purchased by the consumers. It can be used to measure the rate of inflation or the cost of living.

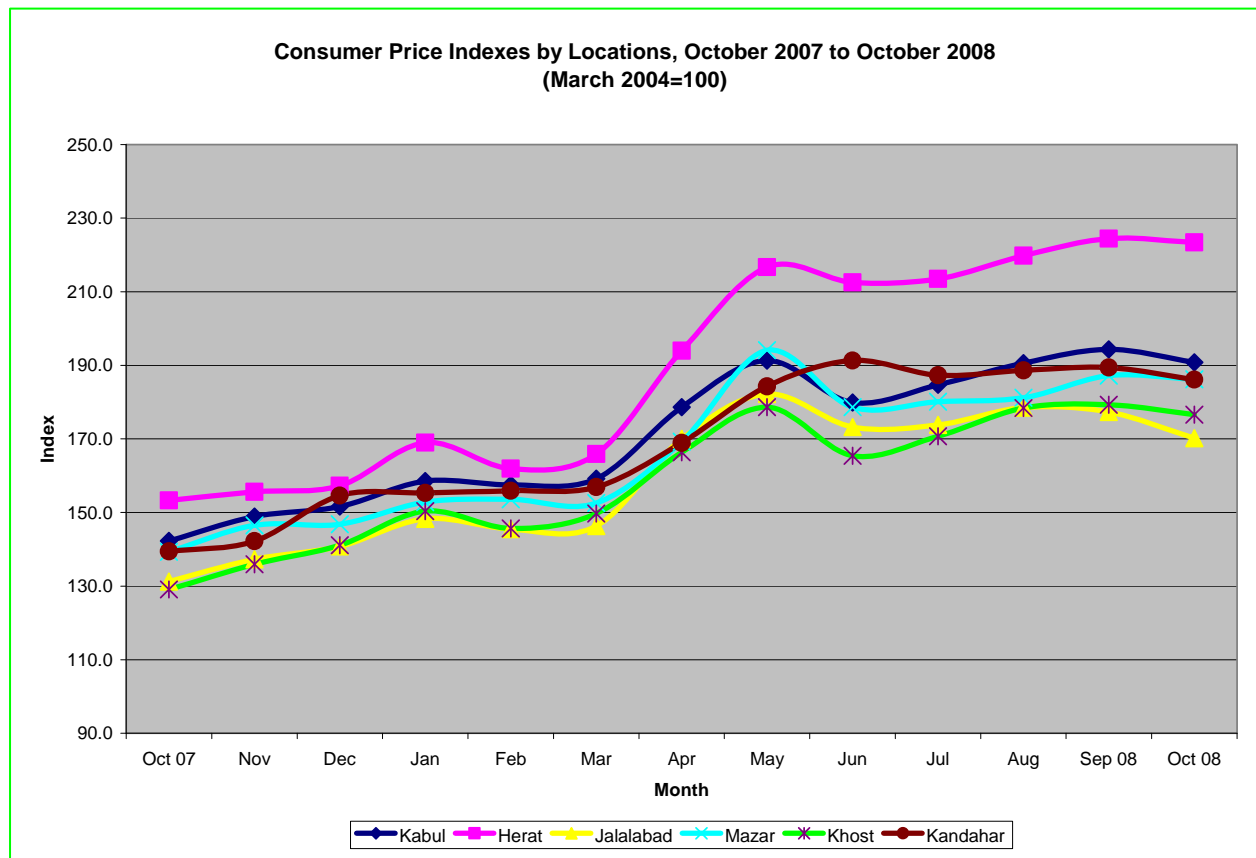

Of the six locations that report CPI data, highest annual inflation-rates were observed in Herat (an increase in overall CPI by 70.1 percent points), Kabul (48.5), Khost (47.5) and Mazar (46.9). Highest annual inflation-rates for food items were reported from Herat (up 100.5 percent points), Mazar (74.1), Kandahar (68.8), Kabul (64.4) and Khost (63.5). For non-food items, highest annual inflation rates were experienced in Herat (23.6), Khost (22.0) and Kabul (17.2). Of the six locations Mazar experienced the least increase in annual CPI for non-food items (4.8 percent points). (Table 2/Annex I/II)

In Kabul, overall CPI rose by 48.5 percent points in one year ending October 08. Annual increases in food and non-food indexes in that period were 68.1 and 17.2 percent points, respectively. A significant annual increase (126.6%) in the index prices of “bread and cereals” was noted, in particular. Overall CPI decreased by 3.5 percent points in September to October, with 5.0 and 1.1 percent point decreases in food and non-food indexes, respectively. (Table 3; next page)

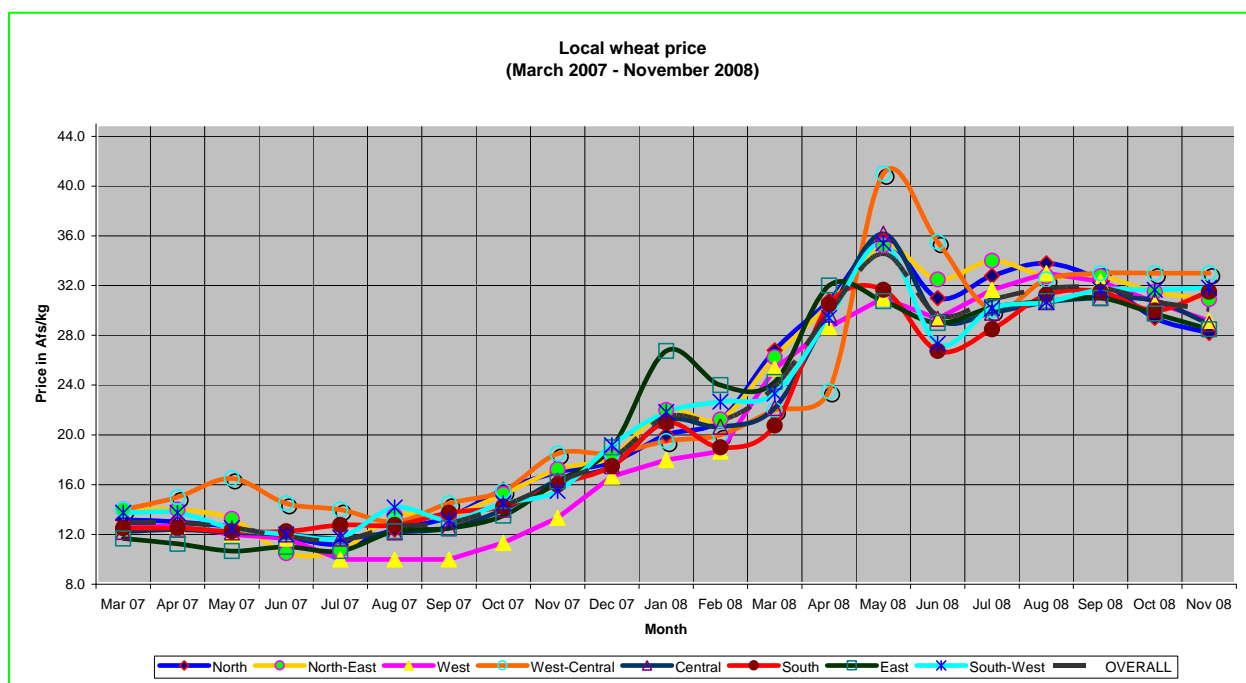
2.1. Price of wheat

Average price of wheat in October 2008 was Afs 30.7/kg, which is lower by 3.4% compared with its price in September 2008. However, price of local wheat in October 2008 is still 115.0% higher than its price in October 2007. Table 4 shows price of local wheat by regions.

From the third and fourth weeks of May, wheat price showed decreasing trend. The prices in June and July also indicated decreases. The decreases were consistent across provinces and were in line with the decreasing trend of wheat price on global markets. Since July the decreasing trend ceased till September. However, the price in October and early November exhibited decreasing trend, mirroring the price trend on global markets.

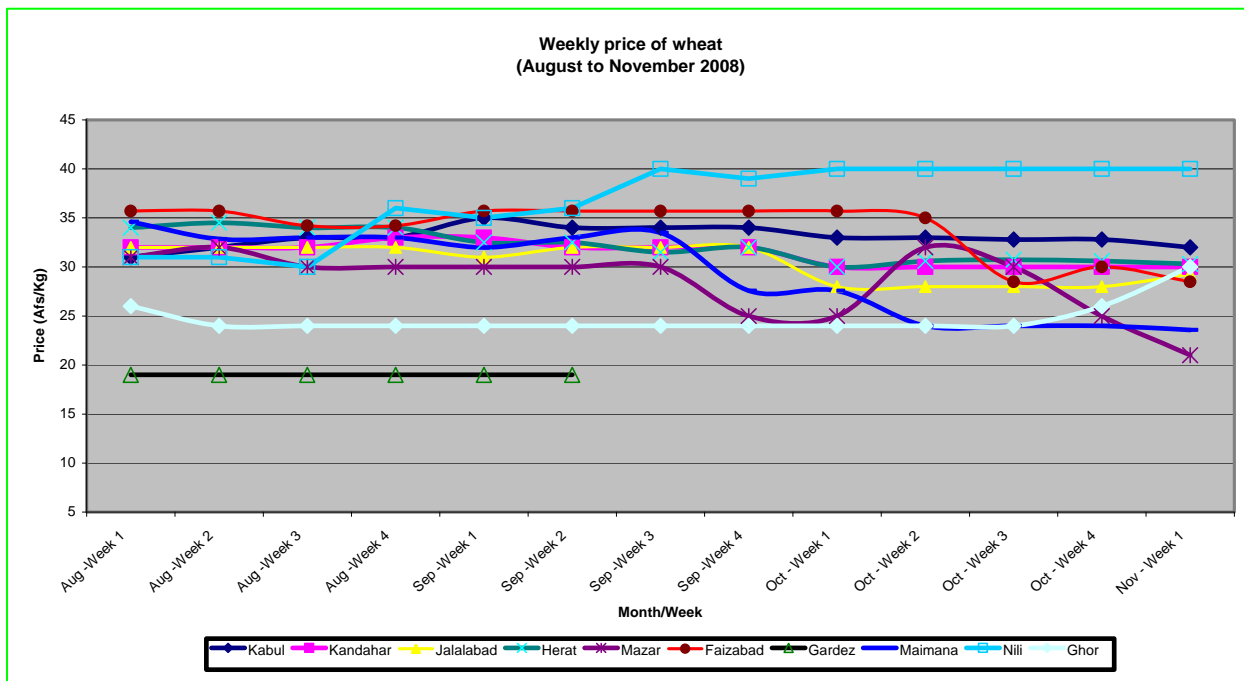

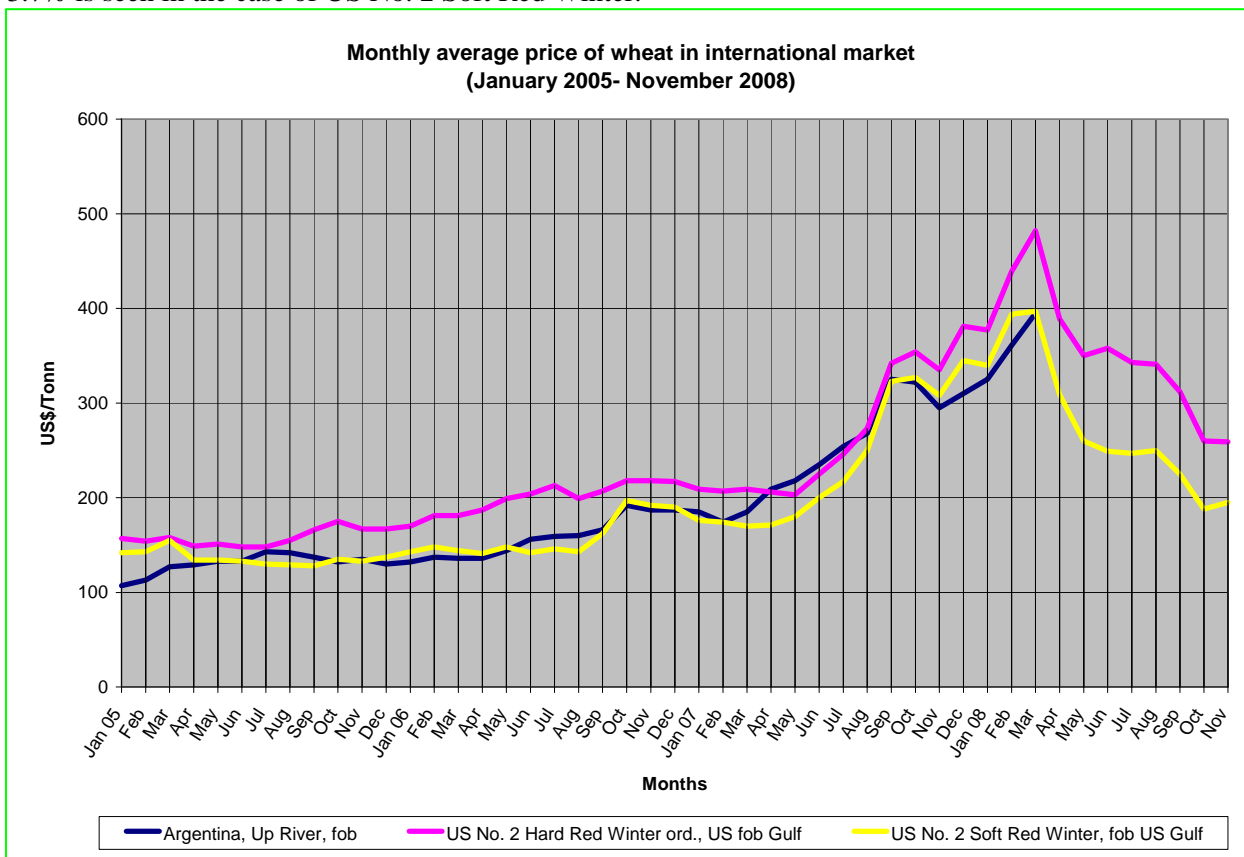

On global market, price of wheat (US No. 2 Hard Red Winter and US No. 2 Soft Red Winter) showed a mixed trend in July. It decreased by 3-4% in August. A decrease by 8.5% for US Hard and 10% for soft was reported in September. Further decrease in the price (12%-17%) was reported in October. Price of US No. 2 Hard Red Winter remains at the same price level in November. However, an increase in price by 3.7% is seen in the case of US No. 2 Soft Red Winter.



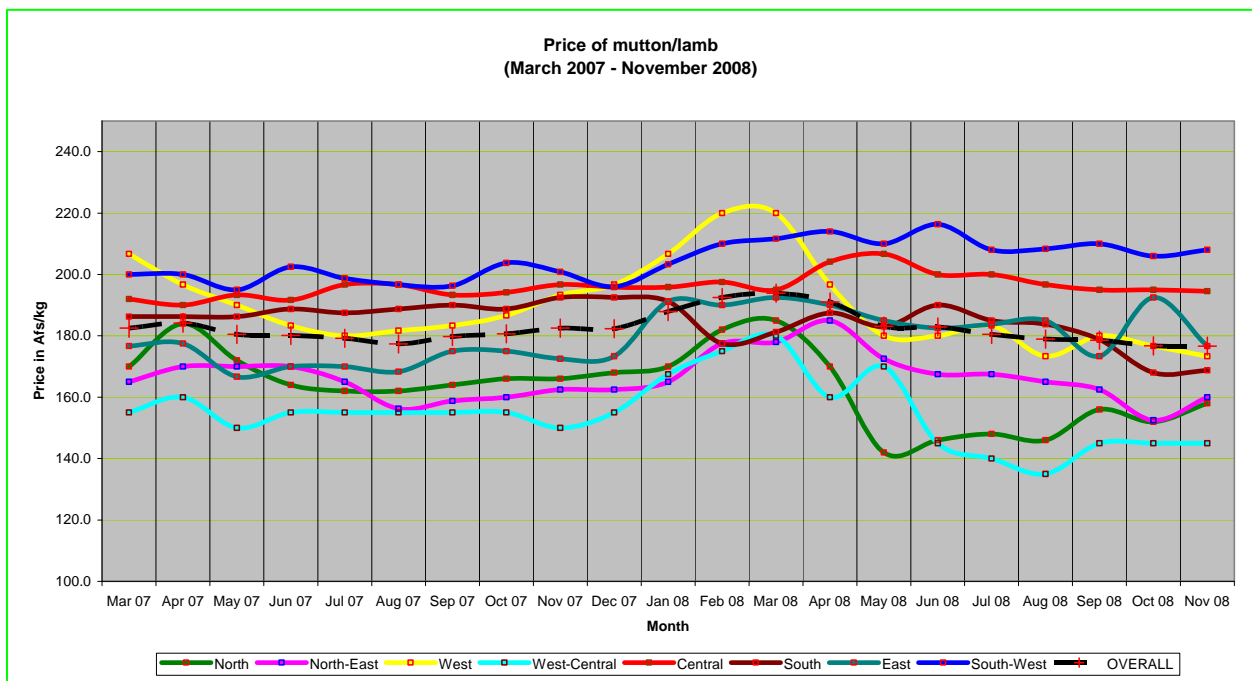
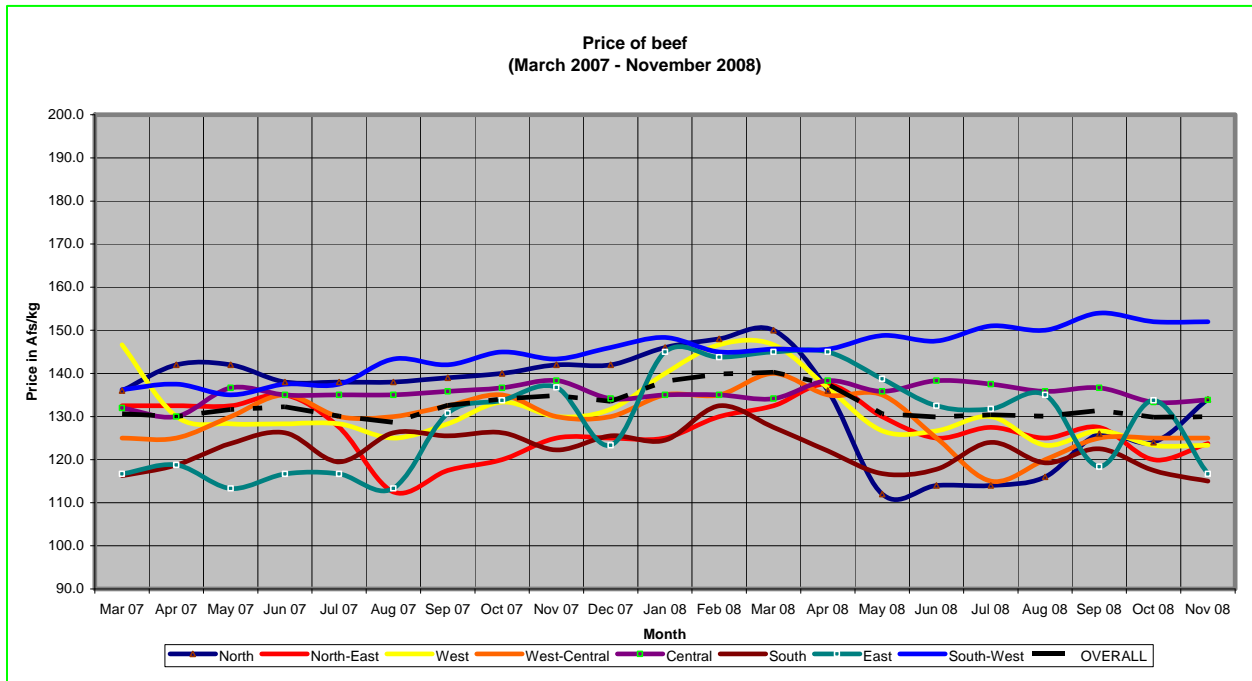

2.2. Price of fruits and vegetables

2.3. Price of livestock and livestock products

In October 08 national average prices of beef, mutton/lamb and chicken were Afs 130/kg, 182/kg, and Afs 105/kg, respectively. Price of mutton rose by 1.7% in the reporting period; prices of beef and chicken remained almost at the same level. Price of beef and mutton in early November remained at Afs 130/kg and Afs 182/kg, respectively. (Next two Graphs below and Summary Table 2)

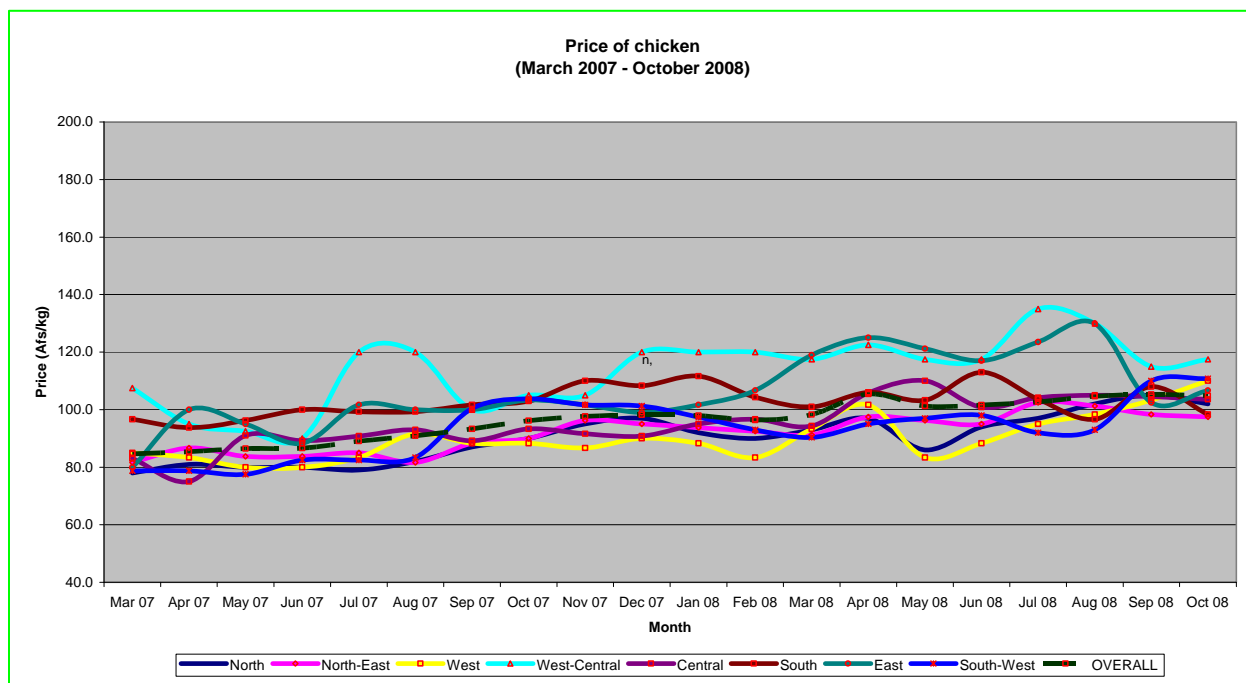

2.5. Price of fertilizers²

Average price of best quality, imported urea was Afs 18.8 in October 2008, which is higher by 4.2% compared to its price in September. Average annual increase in its price is 41.2%. (Annex IV and Summary Table)

Average price of the best quality DAP in October 08 was Afs 50.7/kg. This translates into 9.5% increase in a month's period and 104.3% increase in one year. (Annex IV and Summary Table)
